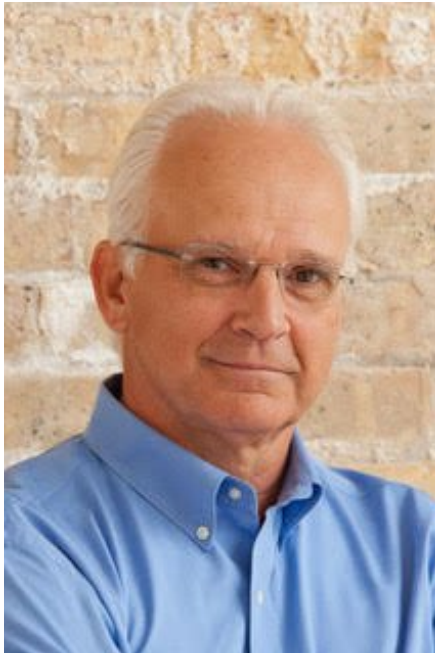

AIM Exams

Congratulations to all students and their teachers that successfully completed AIM this year. This was our first year that we were able to have in person and remote exams for all AIM exams since the pandemic. With slight dip in our numbers during the pandemic, we appear to be gaining back with strong showing in numbers all across the board! The new website and member portals allowed for greater ease of registrations and communicating important information to both teachers and students/parents in an effective and timely manner. A huge thanks goes to Jason Craft and Jia-Yee Tang for their continual, endless efforts all year long to make this happen.

Here is a snapshot of what was implemented this year:

- Both in-person and remote exam options were offered for all AIM exams. Students selected their exam preferences at registrations.
- Teachers were required to complete Mock Exam Judging before they were able to register students for Performance Exams.
- Teacher responsibilities include:
 - Use of Judges and Teacher Folders via member portal to share electronic files
 - Aural-Written exam grading of their own students
 - Checking of ALL video and music file links for remote performance exams for their own students

How did our numbers compare to last year?

*How many teachers participated in AIM this year? **75** And in 2022? **83***

*How many participating teachers were new? **7** And in 2022? **11***

*How many students were enrolled in AIM this year? **715** And in 2022? **674***

*How many students were new to AIM this year? **230** And in 2022? **166***

*How many level 1's and 2's were enrolled this year? **154** And in 2022? **121***

*How many level 9 students were enrolled this year? **51** And in 2022? **41***

*How about level 10? **40** And in 2022? **36***

*And level 11? **18** And in 2022? **13***

*How many students have made it all the way to level 12? **37** And in 2022? **32** (12 still pending)*

*What level had the largest number of enrollments? **Level 4** with **96** And in 2022? **Level 4** with **95***

What was the breakdown of in person and remote exams this year?

- *Levels 3-12 at Lake Forest? **57% in person, 43% remote***
- *Levels 3-12 at Northwestern? **68% in person, 33% remote***
- *Levels 1-2? **90% in person, 10% remote***

May 15 was the deadline to complete make-up exams and request to all teachers to verify accuracy of student rosters. AIM Awards have been ordered, so we will notify teachers when they are ready for pickup. We hope to have these by the end of May, but please be patient if we encounter shipping delays.

Thank you to all teachers for your participation in AIM! We have already begun preparations for next year's exams, with most things remaining the same, but there will be some changes that will be forthcoming. Have a wonderful summer!
